Before making payment, please ensure all the members you are paying fees for are familiar with the following safety and equipment use rules and other information. The rules are also displayed in the club containers and should be followed at all times.

By completing the Membership Form, you acknowledge that:

- you have read and understood the KKRC rules set out in this Membership information sheet; and
- you agree to adhere to and follow these rules, along with any other rules introduced by KKRC at all times.

KKRC Safety and Equipment Use Rules

- Life jackets must be worn at all times.
- Wear appropriate clothing for the conditions.
- Only use club boats that have been authorised for your skill level by KKRC coaches.
- All paddlers in club boats must be accompanied by a capable paddler able to assist them to shore in the event of a capsize.

- Tell someone on shore your intentions before heading out.
- Only club members in club boats.
- Club equipment shall not be taken off site.
- Boats including rudders and paddles must only touch water (you will be charged for any damage caused by careless use).
- No water access when there is a closure on lake zones 4 & 5.
- Do not use boats marked Private.

Navigation Safety Rules

Please also familiarise yourself and comply with Waikato Regional Council Navigation Safety Rules. These cover operating rules on the lake such as give way rules, lighting at night and means of communication. A summary of the rules can be found here:
